Venetian Gardens Service Limitations

Venetian Gardens cannot care for every applicant who wished to receive services. Venetian Gardens has certain service limitations due to size, locations, composition, staffing, and equipment. Venetian Gardens cannot care for residents with any of the following diagnosis and/or identified problems:

- Ventilator Patients
- Persons who are registered sex offenders
- Persons who are pregnant
- Persons who are incarcerated
- Persons with active TB
- Persons who are under the age of eighteen (18) years old
- Persons requiring IV heparin or IV insulin
- Persons requiring Telemetry
- Persons that are a threat to themselves or others
- Persons in alcohol or drug abuse withdrawls

Resident and/or Resident Representatives are required to disclose all conditions and diagnosis prior to or upon admission to our facility, and we will discuss these service limitations with you upon admission. If you fail to disclose any of the above conditions at the time of admission or one of the above conditions is identified or develops after admission, Venetian Gardens may seek to discharge you if we can no longer meet your needs.
